Provincial Tenure – 2016

- Mooring buoys in Mannion Bay are subject to a nominal annual fee (\$240/year) – Bylaw passed 2017
- Owners of unoccupied and recreational vessels mooring in the Bay for greater than 48 hours in a 30 day period are required to provide BIM with proof of insurance, name, phone number, address and email address

Use of Public Beaches and Water Area Bylaw 418 - 2016









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Voluntary No Anchor Zone

- SeaChange Marine Conservation Society
- First of its kind in the Canadian side of the Salish Sea
- Builds upon successful model implemented in the State of Washington
- Marker buoys outline zone and ask boaters to anchor outside of eelgrass habitat












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Seagrass-Friendly Moorings

- SeaChange Marine Conservation Society and the boating community
- Mid-line float system holds lines above the sea floor
- Prevents scouring and damage to eelgrass beds
